LINDA ARNOLD CHOSEN AS THE 2011 ANDY WARHOL ARTIST IN RESIDENCE

Linda Arnold has been selected as the 2011 Andy Warhol Artist in Residence. This award is given to an artist to pursue artistic endeavors at the Andy Warhol Preserve. Arnold will teach a workshop during her stay at the Preserve, a protected area in Montauk, Long Island which includes the ecologically significant Montauk Moorlands.

Arnold is a landscape painter who lives in New York City, but she has had the opportunity to paint in many different locations around the United States and Mexico for over thirty years. Her favorite locations are always at the ocean. While painting at the Preserve in August, 2011, she will have the rare opportunity to study that area in depth. Arnold explains, "I have always loved the act of painting a place many times, and feel that painting and repainting allows the painter to get to know a place in the same way we get to know another person. The painter is fully immersed in the experience and almost becomes part of the landscape. In that contemplation I find that I can let the place take over."

Linda Arnold received a BA from Northwestern University and an MA from the University of Michigan. She has studied at the Art Students League and the National Academy School of Fine Art. She received the Robert Lehman Endowment Fund Scholarship which granted her a travel prize and led to the opportunity to paint with the Plein Air Painters of America. An accomplished plein air painter, Arnold has taught workshops on painting on location, lectured on that topic at the National Academy and was the subject of a feature article in Vero Beach Magazine. She has an active exhibition schedule with work in many private and public collections in the United States, England and Canada. A recipient of numerous awards, Arnold was honored for her commitment to the National Academy School in 2008.
